What Is Each One, Reach One?

It is a program that aims to grow the membership of NCSS. Recruit new members, and you'll be eligible to receive various prizes!

How Does It Work?

Each new member application that lists you as the sponsor also enters your name in a random drawing. For example, sign up 12 colleagues or preservice teachers to be new members of NCSS, and your name will be entered 12 times in the "Each One, Reach One" drawing each spring. To be entered in the drawing, your (the sponsor's) name and membership number must appear on the (new member's) application/brochure.

What Are The Prizes?

A. Annual Conference Registration and Hotel! If you recruit from 1 to 10 new members, your name will go into the random drawing (1 to 10 times) for a full registration plus one night at a designated hotel at the NCSS Annual Conference.

B. Two Free Airline Tickets! If you recruit 11 or more new members, your name will go into the random drawing (11 or more times) to receive two free airline tickets to anywhere in the continental United States! A winner will be chosen in the spring and announced in the *TSSP* newsletter. (Prizes cannot be exchanged or redeemed for cash.)

This year's winner of a registration for the NCSS Annual Conference and one free hotel night is **Meghan McGlenn Manfra**, an associate professor of social studies education at North Carolina State University. Meghan's research focuses on the integration of technology in social studies teacher education and action research for teacher professional development. She is currently the chair elect of the Executive Board of the College and University Faculty Assembly (CUFA) of NCSS, and serves as the co-editor of the technology section of *Social Education*. She is also the editor of the social studies section of the Contemporary Issues in *Technology and Teacher Education (CITE)* journal. She has published over 26 journal articles and book chapters and is the editor of the forthcoming *Handbook of Social Studies Research* (Wiley Press, 2016).

This year's winner of two free airline tickets to anywhere in the continental United States is **Sandi Horn**. Sandi has been an associate professor of education at Bethel University in St. Paul, Minnesota, since 1997. She teaches the social studies methods course for elementary education candidates, as well as handling administrative duties for the department. Prior to that, she was with the Forest Lake Area School District for 23 years, where she taught fourth and fifth grades, eventually serving as the elementary social studies department chair. She served as the curriculum coordinator for the latter half of her time with the school district.
